
On March 8, myself and Anna Thibodeau will be entertaining at the Minto seniors' hall as our January date was cancelled due to weather, here's the poster:



On March 15, member Claudette Norman and her granddaughter Zaida Norman will entertain at a coffee house in Oakhill NB, here's the poster:






